ST. CLOUD MAIN STREET HISTORIC PRESERVATION AWARDS CRITERIA & APPLICATION CHECKLIST

CRITERIA

1. Property must be located within the St. Cloud city limits and must be a minimum of 50 years old.
2. Property must comply with the City of St. Cloud Historic Preservation Ordinance.
3. Property may not have unresolved code enforcement violations.
4. Entire property must be evaluated (garages, sheds, fences, site, etc.).
5. All work must be complete at the time of application. Properties with open building permits or otherwise in process may not be considered. All work must be completed no more than two years prior to application.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED

Please provide a project narrative on a separate sheet that addresses each of the following questions:

- What is the history of the property?
- What changes have happened to the property over time?
- What are the defining features/characteristics of the property?
- How has the project maintained, restored, or replicated defining features/characteristics of the property?
- What challenges were faced/overcome during the project?
- Are there any other important details you would like to share about the historical, cultural, or architectural contributions made possible by this project?

AWARDS CATEGORIES AND DESCRIPTIONS

Preservation: Work that has been undertaken to sustain the existing form, integrity, and materials of a historic property. This includes measures to protect and stabilize the property, generally focusing upon the ongoing maintenance and repair of historic materials and features rather than extensive replacement and new construction.

Rehabilitation: The act or process of making possible a compatible use for a property through repair, alterations, and additions while preserving those portions or features which convey its historical, cultural, archaeological or architectural significance.

Restoration: The act or process of accurately depicting the form, features, and character of a property as it appeared at a particular period of time by means of the removal of features from other periods in its history and reconstruction of missing features from the restoration period.

Additions/New Construction: The construction of new features to a historic property or site that are compatible and in character with the existing historic building and surrounding contributing historic resources.
