Buildings that have been determined by St. Cloud Main Street to contribute to the historic significance of the city are eligible for a bronze plaque in recognition of the building's historic value. These plaques are intended to promote public appreciation and civic pride in our community's history. Purchase and installation of a historic preservation plaque does not restrict the use or maintenance of your property. If your property is determined to no longer contribute to the historic significance of the city (as a result of alterations or significant deterioration, natural or man-made), St. Cloud Main Street reserves the right to remove the plaque, without reimbursement to the property owner.

St. Cloud Main Street is not responsible for damage caused to the plaque or building during installation, improper maintenance, aging, or theft. Plaques are issued once annually during May, National Historic Preservation Month. Applications must be received no later than February 13th of each year to be eligible for a plaque in May of the same calendar year.

ST. CLOUD MAIN STREET HISTORIC PRESERVATION PLAQUE DESIGN

Plaques are constructed of cast bronze and are 6 inches in diameter. All lettering on the plaque is in a raised lettered format upon a bronze background. Installation hardware is included.

If the building listed above in the “Property Information” section is determined to be contributing to the historic significance of the city, the plaque will contain the following information:

Plaque must be installed adjacent to the main entry door, at least 18” away from the door frame, and located at eye level. Fasteners installed in brick must be done in the mortar joint, avoiding the brick.
